

## Announcements:

About make up points from test 1:

- You will be able to redo some problems similar to problems from test 1 to raise your score on test 1
- You will be taking these problems during/after test 2
- You will be able to earn back half of the points you lost on any particular problem (half, rounded up. For example, if a problem was worth 9 points and you got 4 points, you may earn up to  $(9-4)/2=2.5$  points rounded up to 3 points—you may earn up to 3 more points.

About homework:

- The extra practice problems for test 1 make up are considered homework problems. If you got 80% or better on test 1, you are exempt, and you do not have to do these problems.
- Starting today (Oct 10), the first 10-15 minutes of class will be a homework quiz.
  - It will consist of approximately 3 problems taken from or very similar to the homework problems.
  - You may use your phone as your calculator for quizzes.
  - The quiz score will be your homework score
  - If you don't have time to complete the quiz or if you feel you did better work on your homework, you may turn in your homework along with the quiz and a request to grade the homework problem(s) instead of the quiz problems.
