2A. Amy and Lisa together have 8 carrots. Lisa has 5 carrots. How many does Amy have?	2B. Lisa had 8 carrot sticks in her lunch. She gave some carrot sticks to Amy, and she had 5 carrot sticks left. How many carrots did she give to Amy?
3A. The popcorn club made bags of popcorn to sell at snack time. They sold 16 bags of popcorn at snack time, and they had 5 bags left over that didn't get sold. How many bags of popcorn did they start with?	3B. The kids in the classroom have 16 bags of popcorn. There are 5 bags of popcorn in a box in the corner. How many bags of popcorn are there in all?
4A. There are 5 blue origami frogs that Sam made before lunch, and some green origami frogs that he made after lunch. There are 9 origami frogs in all. How many green frogs are there?	4B. Sam has 5 origami frogs. How many more frogs does he have to make to have 9 frogs?
5A. Andrea had some bracelets. Her friend Sarah gave her 2 more bracelets, and now she has 8 bracelets. How many bracelets did Andrea have before Sarah gave her some?	5B. Andrea has 8 bracelets. Two of the bracelets are ones she just got from Sarah, and the rest are ones she has had for a long time. How many bracelets has she had for a long time?
6A. There are 8 balloons. 3 of the balloons are high up in the sky. How many balloons are not high up in the sky?	6B. Mary has 8 balloons. 3 of them fly away. How many balloons does she have left?
7A. There are 9 pink Starbursts and 6 yellow Starbursts left in the candy bowl. How many more pink Starbursts than yellow Starbursts are there?	7B. There are 9 cupcakes. 6 of the cupcakes have frosting. How many of the cupcakes don't have frosting (yet)?
8A. Annie has 10 crayons. Some of them are new crayons, but 2 of them are not new. How many new crayons does Annie have?	8B. Frank has 10 crayons on his desk. Frank has 2 more crayons than Rachel. How many crayons does Rachel have?
9A. Kelly has 3 more markers than pencils. She has 6 pencils. How many markers does she have?	9B. Sandra has 6 pink erasers and 3 blue erasers. How many erasers does she have?
