 Understand a fraction $\frac{1}{b}$ as the quantity formed by 1 part when a whole is partitioned into b equal parts; understand a fraction $\frac{a}{b}$ as the quantity formed by a parts of size $\frac{1}{b}$.

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Adding Fractions

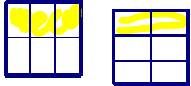
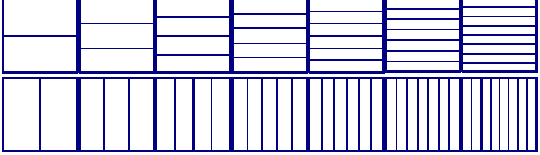
$\frac{1}{2} + \frac{1}{3}$

> Find Common Denom
 > Find Equivalent Fractions
 > Add

Fractions can have different names
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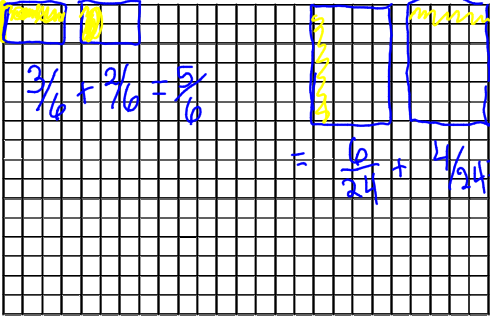



$\frac{1}{2} + \frac{1}{3}$

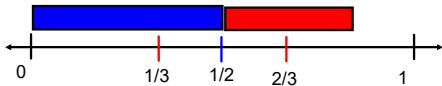
$\frac{1}{4} + \frac{1}{6}$

$= \frac{3}{6} + \frac{2}{6} = \frac{5}{6}$

$= \frac{5}{24} + \frac{4}{24} = \frac{10}{24}$



$\frac{1}{2} + \frac{1}{3}$



$\frac{1}{2} \times \frac{1}{3}$ 3x4 means 3 taken 4 times
 a group has 3 wholes in it, and I take 4 groups

$\frac{1}{2} \times \frac{1}{3}$ must mean 1/2 taken 1/3 times
 a group has 1/2 of a whole unit in it,
 and I take 1/3 of a group

$\frac{1}{2}$ is $\frac{1}{2}$ of \bigcirc .

$\frac{1}{2} \times \frac{1}{3}$ is ∇ which is $\frac{1}{3}$ of \smile .
